BLUESKY CHARTER SCHOOL POLICY No. 1.2 EQUAL EDUCATIONAL OPPORTUNITY

I. PURPOSE

BlueSky Charter School must operate in compliance with federal and state laws including the Minnesota Human Rights Act, regarding non-discriminatory practices in the school setting.

II. POLICY STATEMENT

- A. BlueSky Charter School will provide equal educational opportunity for all students.
- B. BlueSky Charter School will not unlawfully discriminate on the basis of race, color, creed, religion, national origin, sex, age, marital status, parental status, status with regard to public assistance, disability, or sexual orientation.
- C. BlueSky Charter School will make reasonable accommodations for disabled students.
- D. Each BlueSky Charter School administrator and staff member must comply with this policy. Failure to comply will result in appropriate discipline.
- E. Students or parents should contact the BlueSky Charter School Executive Director with any questions or concerns regarding this policy or its implementation.
