- Daily access to Windows 10 or higher/Mac OS 10.13 or higher computer (iPads and Chromebooks may work for some courses but are not fully supported)
- Headset (or mic and speakers)
- Webcam
- High speed internet (5 Mbps download/3 Mbps upload minimum recommended)
