### 20-21 Annual Report

Each year, school districts develop a World's Best Workforce (WBWF) and Annual Report, engage in an annual public meeting with stakeholders, and release the annual report publicly on district websites. Under Minnesota Statutes, section 120B.11, the annual report and annual meetings are focused on strategies and initiatives that the district engaged in to meet the goals and the progress made on those goals in the prior school year. The goals must address the following areas:

- All children are ready for school. • All third-graders can read at grade level.
- All racial and economic achievement gaps •
- between students are closed. • All students are ready for career and
- college. • All students graduate from high school.

In addition, WBWF legislation requires that districts submit a summary of the annual report to MDE (Minnesota Department of Education) each year. BlueSky has recently added our 20-21 Annual <u>Report and World's Best Workforce Summary to</u> our website. Take a look at both documents to find out the results of BlueSky's goals as well as learn

all about the innovative programs we have implemented as a way to support each and every one of our students.

Occupational therapy assistants carry out activities and exercises with clients based on a treatment plan developed in collaboration with an occupational therapist. Occupational therapy assistants monitor an individual's activities to make sure they are performed correctly and to provide encouragement. They also record their client's progress for use by the occupational therapist.

Students who have GPAs in the 2.5-3.5 range are ideal candidates for this program. Application for Admission


