## **BLUESKY CHARTER SCHOOL POLICY No. 5.2.2 COMPULSORY ATTENDANCE**

### **I. PURPOSE**

The purpose of this policy is to reiterate BlueSky Charter School's commitment to ensuring that all families and students comply with Minnesota's Compulsory Attendance Law.

### **II. POLICY STATEMENT**

It is the policy of BlueSky Charter School that all members of the school community, including all teachers, staff, parents and students understand the importance of all students' regular attendance at school. To that end, all members of the school community, teachers, staff, parents and students are responsible for ensuring that students meet the attendance requirements contained in BlueSky Charter School's Policy 5.2.1 on attendance and to promptly report any unexcused absences so that they might be dealt with in a timely and effective manner.

### **III. NONCOMPLIANCE WITH POLICY**

Any BlueSky Charter School officer, truant officer, teacher, principal, administrator or person providing instruction who refuses, willfully fails or neglects to perform any duty imposed by Policy 5.2.1 will be subject to discipline up to and including termination.
